



Developed from Dr Sands' research, counselling and group programmes with children bereaved through suicide. Includes children's drawings, memories, words and voices, and a DVD resource.






## A Loss Too Soon

Practical advice and guidance for parents at the time of their baby's death in hospital. Room for professionals to write in local sources of support.


